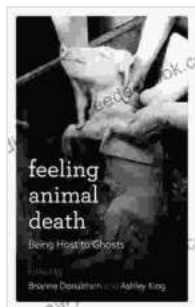


Feeling Animal Death: Can Animals Perceive the Presence of Ghosts?
