

Fun New Addition and Subtraction Activity for Ages 4 - 6

What You'll Need

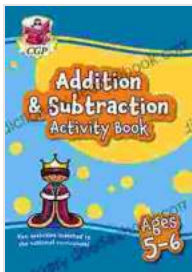
- A piece of paper

- Ask your child to solve addition and subtraction problems in their head. For example, you could ask them to add 2 and 3 in their head or subtract 3 from 5 in their head.

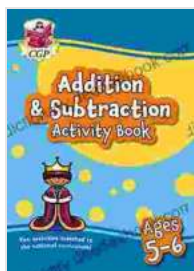
Benefits
