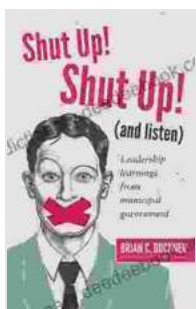
What is Municipal Government?

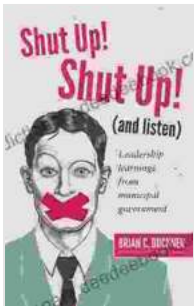
