magical words and enchanting illustrations. They laughed at the adventures of a brave knight and shed tears over the plight of a lost princess.

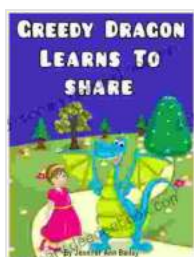
As the sun began its descent, casting long shadows across the cave, the children finished the book. With heavy hearts, they prepared to say goodbye to Sparky and his wonderful tales.
